



Booking and Exhibition FAQ

Thank you for your interest in joining us in this transformative work toward dismantling racism.

There are 11 quilts, all 4 feet wide and varying from 3-7 feet tall. A room 30' x 40' or 25' x 50' works well to display half the quilts down each long wall, leaving room for people to view both the fronts and backs of the quilts.

A donation of \$500 is requested to cover our expenses and further the anti-racist work of the Sacred Ally Quilt Ministry.

If an in-person sacred conversation with Rev. Mark Koyama and Dr. Harriet Ward is desired, this needs to be arranged with them. Reimbursement for expenses including flights and hotels is required.

A 17-minute documentary titled "Stitch, Breathe, Speak" was professionally produced by Ribeye Media and is a powerful film to accompany viewing the quilts. Important exhibit information:

- NO FOOD or DRINK is allowed in the room with the quilts.
- NO ONE is to touch the quilts.
- Only people with GLOVED HANDS may handle the quilts to install and strike the display.
- Quilts must be monitored by a staff person or trained volunteer when the exhibit is open.
- The room must be secured when the display is closed.
- No quilts are for sale.
- We provide everything needed for the exhibit including publicity materials.
- The quilts may be photographed.

For tours only:

4 months of preparation time is needed to properly plan an exhibit tour. We ask that an organization first identify a point person who will coordinate the tour and communicate with contact people at all the venues, including churches and universities. Once this point person has been identified and exhibit locations are proposed, a Zoom meeting can be held with the SAQM coordinators to work on logistics around transportation and share expectations regarding care and security of the quilts.

Hosts will be responsible for costs of shipping the quilts.
